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

### Reading

We are working on the comprehension skill of comparing and contrasting in reading right now. We are reading a variety of texts, both fiction and nonfiction, and looking at how they are similar and different. We are comparing characters, settings, themes, and plots of fiction, and different aspects of nonfiction.

## Writing

We are wrapping up our persuasive paragraphs, see if your child was able to persuade you! Next week we will be looking at school issues, such as, "Should students chew gum in class?" or "Should schools have uniforms?", etc., and take a position to defend. We will choose an issue that we are interested in and write an essay defending our stance. I am seeing real improvement in the essays already.

#### Math

We have been working hard on area, and we now moved on to look at a different aspect of geometry, identifying and classifying a variety of polygons. We are learning different attributes polygons might have (symmetry, parallel lines, perpendicular lines, etc.) and comparing and contrasting these different shapes. We will continue working on these concepts over the next week or two, working on applying what we learned to problem solving activities. Time tests continue every Thursday. Check the Friday folder to see which facts your child is working on.

#### **Science**

In earth science we are learning about different natural resources we have in the earth, focusing on nonrenewable resources. We will continue our study of nonrenewable resources and how we use them next week.
