## Reading

We have done a lot of sequencing these past few weeks. We put the events of a historical event—the sinking of the Titanic—in sequential order. We also wrote a paragraph and explained how to make an origami bear by putting those in order. Next week we will be learning about cause and effect and how it relates to reading.

# Writing

Our stories are looking great! We created interesting characters and mapped out the problem and solution to our story. We wrote strong lead and are developing our characters with description and action. Next week we will write the climax and ending of our story and then work on our final copies. We hope to finish them by the end of the week.

## Math

We are deep in the middle of our fraction unit. This week we did math performance task and problem solving to work on applying the concepts we are learning to real life situation. These were challenging problems, and the children stuck with it and came up with solutions and were able to defend their answer. Next week we will do more work with fractions greater than one and comparing fractions with like and unlike denominators.

#### Science
